

Medicine Hat Family Service Elder Abuse Case Management Program

Elder Abuse Case Management is provided by Medicine Hat Family Service to people age 50 and older. Referrals are accepted from anyone interested in the well-being of older adults.

Elder Abuse is any action or inaction by a person in a trusting relationship that causes harm and distress to an older adult within the scope of physical, emotional, psychological, financial, sexual and medication abuse or neglect.

As a long-time resident of Medicine Hat, Jeanette Devore facilitates the Elder Abuse Case Management Program. She has advocated for older adults through her outreach roles with the public service and community agencies.

Jeanette works closely with older adults, families, care partners and service providers to:

- Offer assessment, support and case management to those at risk of or experiencing elder abuse.
- Provide education, advocacy and referral services.
- Navigate complex systems for the best possible outcomes.
- Increase knowledge, skills and competence to help end elder abuse.
